## Globe columnist wins literary prize

From Tuesday's Globe and Mail

Globe columnist Susan Pinker just added the American Psychological Association's most prestigious literary prize to the mounting plaudits for her international bestseller, *The Sexual Paradox: Men, Women and the Real Gender Gap*. Announced at the association's annual convention in Toronto this weekend, the William James Award honours "a recent book that serves to integrate material across psychological subfields or to provide coherence to the diverse subject matter of psychology," with a special emphasis on literary quality, as demonstrated by its namesake, a founder of modern psychology and author of *The Varieties of Religious Experience*.
